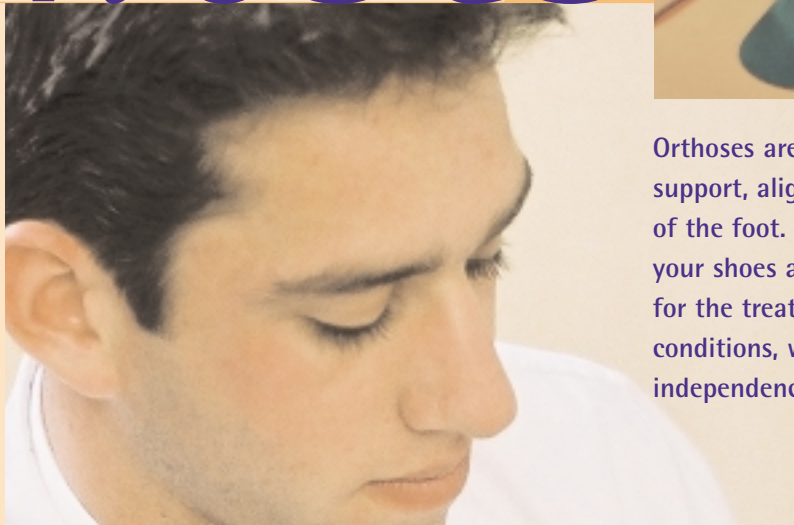


Orthoses

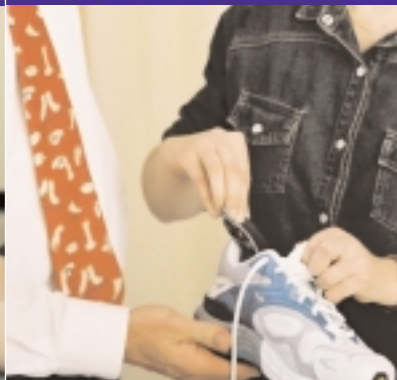
